Telephone Service Surcharge (E911) in its tariff.

**ISSUE:**

On August 1, 2014 Navajo submitted a filing to include the Emergency Telephone Service Surcharge (E911) in its tariff.

**RECOMMENDATION: Approve tariff filing.**

The DPU reviewed this filing and has no objection to Navajo introducing the language describing the mandatory E911 surcharge. The E911 surcharge in Utah is based on current applicable rates as stated in Section 69-2 of the Utah Code. The language refers to this code rather than listing it every time there is a change in the rate. This type of change does not affect basic rates and does not require a rate hearing. The Division therefore recommends it become effective September 1, 2014 as requested.
