On September 28, 2000, the Public Service Commission (Commission) issued certificate of public convenience and necessity (CPCN) No. 2320 to Unity Telecom, LLC f/k/a dPi Teleconnect, LLC (Unity Telecom). On September 29, 2014, Unity Telecom filed a request to surrender its CPCN. The Division of Public of Utilities (Division) subsequently filed a recommendation to approve Unity Telecom's request. The Division recommendation states that "[Unity Telecom] . . . state[s] that [it] ha[s] no customers within the State of Utah. It appears [Unity Telecom] ha[s] complied with the rules for exiting as required under Administrative Rule R746-350."<sup>1</sup>

ORDER

For the foregoing reasons, Certificate No. 2320, issued September 28, 2000, is cancelled.

Notice of Opportunity for Agency Review or Rehearing

Pursuant to Utah Code Ann. §§ 63G-4-301 and 54-7-15, a party may seek agency review or rehearing of this order by filing a request for review or rehearing with the Commission within 30 days after the issuance of the order. Responses to a request for agency review or rehearing must be filed within 15 days of the filing of the request for review or rehearing. If the Commission fails to grant a request for review or rehearing within 20 days after the filing of a request for review or rehearing, it is deemed denied. Judicial review of the Commission's final agency action may be obtained by filing a Petition for Review with the Utah Supreme Court within 30 days after final agency action. Any Petition for Review must comply with the requirements of Utah Code Ann. §§ 63G-4-401, 63G-4-403, and the Utah Rules of Appellate Procedure.
