ISSUE:

On January 15, 2015 Citizens submitted a filing to further clarify the definition of Customer Designated Premises (CDP) in the access tariff.

RECOMMENDATION: Approve tariff filing.

The DPU reviewed this filing and has no objection to Citizens updating language in its access tariff to clarify the definition of CPD, since this type of change does not affect basic rates and does not require a rate hearing.
