On March 27, 2015, Emery Telephone Company (Company) filed an application for a distribution from the Utah Universal Service Fund (USF). Within that filing the Company filed both confidential and redacted versions of testimony for Brock Johansen and Darren Woolsey. In reviewing versions of their testimony, the versions were the same without any redactions for confidential information. As such, the Office has not been able to discern between what is confidential and what is not confidential. Without knowing what information is confidential or not, the Office is treating the Company's redacted testimony as confidential and will file its testimony with only confidential versions since it cites information that was available in the redacted version.

The Office will work with the Company to identify what is confidential in the redacted versions of the Company's testimony. The Office will provide the Commission a redacted version of its testimony once the confidential information is identified in the Company's redacted testimony.
