This matter is before the Commission on the application of Qwest Corporation d/b/a CenturyLink QC (“CenturyLink” or the “Company”) for approval of a pole attachment agreement (“Agreement”) with Springville City (“Springville”). On January 29, 2015, CenturyLink filed its application (“Application”), together with copies of the Agreement. Springville and the Company signed the Agreement on December 2, 2014.

On February 27, 2015, the Division of Public Utilities (the “Division”) submitted a recommendation to approve the application. “The Division believes that both parties voluntarily negotiated the proposed contract incorporating most of the terms of the standard contract, while modifying the agreement in other places that were agreed upon during good faith negotiations. ...[N]o other parties have filed any comments opposing this . . . [A]greement. Because the contract was negotiated in good faith, both parties agree, and there is no opposition to the petition, the Division recommends approval.” Division Memo at 1-2, filed February 27, 2015.

ORDER

Having reviewed the application and attachments, the Division’s recommendation, and there being no opposition filed, the Commission finds approval of the application and the Agreement to be just and reasonable, and in the public interest, and we approve the application and the Agreement.

Notice of Opportunity for Agency Review or Rehearing

Pursuant to Utah Code Ann. §§ 63G-4-301 and 54-7-15, a party may seek agency review or rehearing of this order by filing a request for review or rehearing with the Commission within 30 days after the issuance of the order. Responses to a request for agency review or rehearing must be filed within 15 days of the filing of the request for review or rehearing. If the Commission fails to grant a request for review or rehearing within 20 days after the filing of a request for review or rehearing, it is deemed denied. Judicial review of the Commission's final agency action may be obtained by filing a Petition for Review with the Utah Supreme Court within 30 days after final agency action. Any Petition for Review must comply with the requirements of Utah Code Ann. §§ 63G-4-401, 63G-4-403, and the Utah Rules of Appellate Procedure.
