RECOMMENDATION (Acknowledgement):

The Division of Public Utilities ("Division") recommends that the Public Service Commission ("Commission") acknowledge the requested name change from Preferred Long Distance, Inc. to "Preferred Long Distance, Inc. dba Telplex Communications" or shortened "Preferred Long Distance, Inc. dba Telplex" for their retail local exchange and/or interexchange telecommunications and CMRS services. "Preferred Long Distance, Inc. dba Ringplanet Communications" or shortened "Preferred Long Distance, Inc. dba Ringplanet" for their CMRS and/or iVoIP services.

EXPLANATION:

On or about September 30, 2015, Preferred Long Distance, Inc. filed a letter with the Commission indicating their company will be changing their name to from Preferred Long Distance, Inc. to "Preferred Long Distance, Inc. dba Telplex Communications" or shortened "Preferred Long Distance, Inc. dba Telplex" for their retail local exchange and/or interexchange telecommunications and CMRS services. "Preferred Long Distance, Inc. dba Ringplanet Communications" or shortened "Preferred Long Distance, Inc. dba Ringplanet" for their CMRS and/or iVoIP services effective immediately. The name change will not impact any customers in the state of Utah. Additionally Preferred Long Distance, Inc. will not change the services they offer. The Division recommends that the Commission acknowledge the request by Preferred

Long Distance, Inc. to change their corporate name and make the necessary changes and amendments to all the required documents.
