Re: Utah Docket No. 16-043-T02, Corrected DPU response in the Matter of the Petition of Gunnison Telephone Co., for an Increase in Rates to the current Commission proposed Affordable Base.

ISSUE:

Gunnison Telephone Company (Gunnison) is filing revisions to its Network Access Line Service Tariff PSC Utah No. 2, so that with the addition of mandatory EAS (Extended Area Service) charges and State USF (Universal Service Fund) surcharges, it will add up to meet the current Commission proposed Affordable Base Rate rules.

Gunnison is requesting an increase in its basic residential telephone rate to the current Commission proposed "Affordable Base Rate." Manti's current monthly rate for residence is \$16.50 which will increase by \$1.00 to \$17.50.

RECOMMENDATION: Approve proposed residential rates to become effective July 1, 2016 rather than June 1, 2016 which the DPU previously recommended in error.

The above basic rate modifications are pursuant to the Public Service Commission's Notice of Requirement to File a Petition to Amend Tariff or to Deviate from the Utah Affordable Base Rate Notice, issued April 18, 2016, Docket No. 16-R360-01

Since the requested residential rate increase is in compliance with the proposed Utah Affordable Base Rate Notice, the Division recommends that the Commission approve the new updated tariff sheet for Docket No. 16-043-T02 effective **July 1, 2016 as originally requested by Gunnison.**
