Dear Ms. Bettiga,

On January 13, 2016, the Public Service Commission of Utah received a request for a waiver of Threshold Utilization and/or Months to Exhaust requirements (number waiver) by Qwest Corporation dba CenturyLink QC (CenturyLink). The request is for 1 block in the 801 NPA in the Lehi Rate Center, and that a new NXX (801 - NXX) be opened, to serve a customer request which CenturyLink cannot provide based on its current inventory.

Through correspondence, CenturyLink has substantiated a verifiable need on the part of one of its customers for additional numbering resources. Based on the authority delegated to the states in paragraphs 57-66 of the FCC's Third Report and Order on Numbering Resource Optimization, the Public Service Commission of Utah grants CenturyLink's request for a waiver of the Threshold Utilization and/or Months to Exhaust requirements, thereby allowing PA/Neustar to provide CenturyLink with the necessary one number block in the 801 Lehi rate center.
