Re: Letter from Qwest Corporation, dba CenturyLink QC Requesting Relief from Utilization Requirements, Docket No. 16-049-06

Dear Ms. Bettiga,

On May 24, 2016, the Public Service Commission of Utah received a request for a waiver of Threshold Utilization and/or Months to Exhaust requirements by Qwest Corporation, dba CenturyLink QC (CenturyLink). The request is for five blocks of 1,000 sequential numbers (5,000 numbers total), in the 385 NPA, with an NXX that ends with 7, and within the Midvale Rate Center. CenturyLink makes the request in order to meet a specific customer need that exceeds current inventory. The customer initially requested blocks from the 801 NPA; however, after consultation with CenturyLink it has been determined that blocks from the 385 NPA will work as long as the NXX ends in 7. The customer would prefer blocks/numbers within a 385-xx7-2, 385-xx7-3, 385-xx7-4, 385-xx7-5, and 385-xx7-6 range.

Through correspondence, CenturyLink has substantiated a verifiable need on the part of one of its customers for additional numbering resources. Based on the authority delegated to the states in paragraphs 57-66 of the FCC's Third Report and Order on Numbering Resource Optimization, the Public Service Commission of Utah grants CenturyLink's request for a waiver of the Threshold Utilization and/or Months to Exhaust requirements, thereby allowing NANPA to provide CenturyLink with the necessary five number blocks in the 385 Midvale Rate Center.
