## Recommendation (Acknowledge)

The Division of Public Utilities (“Division”) has reviewed the attached filing by Boomerang Wireless, LLC d/b/a enTouch Wireless, (“Boomerang”) that was filed on February 27, 2024. The Division recommends that the Commission Acknowledge receipt of the filing.

## Background

On September 13, 2017, the Commission designated Boomerang as an Eligible Telecommunications Carrier in the State of Utah in Docket No 16-2590-01. As part of the Stipulation, the company was required to file a notification with the Commission regarding any changes to the service offerings.

As required by the Stipulation, Boomerang is filing the updated pricing structure for its minimum standard voice plan. The Division has reviewed the filing and sees no reason to deny the changes. Therefore, the Division recommends the Commission acknowledge the changes.
