Dear Mr. Gipson,

The Public Service Commission (PSC) reviewed the letter filed February 27, 2024 ("Filing") by Boomerang Wireless, LLC d/b/a enTouch Wireless ("enTouch"). The Filing gives notice of an update to enTouch's non-tribal lifeline Bundled Broadband Plan. Specifically, enTouch is adding a \$9.25 bundled plan that is free to subscribers and eligible Lifeline applicants.

The PSC also reviewed the March 5, 2024 comments filed by the Division of Public Utilities (DPU). DPU recommends the PSC acknowledge the Filing. DPU comments that enTouch is required to notify the PSC of any changes to its service offerings under a stipulation approved by the PSC in an order designating enTouch as an Eligible Telecommunications Carrier in Docket No. 16–2590–01, and that it sees no reason to deny enTouch's proposed changes.

Based on the PSC's review of the Filing and on DPU's comments and recommendation, the PSC acknowledges receiving the notice described in enTouch's Filing.
