RECOMMENDATION (Acknowledge):

The Division of Public Utilities ("Division") recommends that the Public Service Commission ("Commission") acknowledge the receipt of this Interconnection Agreement.

EXPLANATION:

On or about June 22, 2017, Navajo Communications Company, d/b/a Frontier Navajo Communications Company ("Navajo Comm") filed an Adoption Agreement for Wireless Telecommunications services per the above-referenced docket in accordance with § 54-8b-2.2(1)(d) of the *Utah Code*. This Agreement has been fully executed through voluntary negotiations on April 10, 2017 with T-Mobile West LLC ("T-Mobile").

The Division has reviewed the above-mentioned Agreement between Navajo Comm and T-Mobile and sees no reason to reject it. Specifically, the Division believes that the Agreement was negotiated in good faith and without unfair discrimination. Both parties also recognize that, to the extent that the existing rules are changed, vacated, dismissed, stayed or modified, this Agreement and all contracts adopting all or part of this Agreement will be amended to reflect such modification or change of the existing rules. Therefore, the Division recommends that the Commission acknowledge the receipt of this Interconnection Agreement.
