## PETITION TO RELINQUISH ITS COMPETITIVE ELIGIBLE TELECOMMUNICATIONS CARRIER DESIGNATION

Beehive Telephone Company, Inc. ("Beehive Telecom" or "CLEC"), filed and received in Docket 06-051-01 a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity("CPCN") as a Competitive Local Exchange Carrier ("CLEC"). - 4. Beehive Telecom has no arrangements or agreements with any other company.
- 5. Beehive Telecom has no assets or liabilities.

Therefore, for the above items, Beehive Telecom requests that its certification as a CLEC in the state of Utah be cancelled.

## **CONCLUSION**

Beehive Telecom respectfully requests that the Commission issue an order granting relinquishment or cancellation of Beehive Telecom's designation as a CLEC.
