# 6.9.5 Nonrecurring Charge for Presubscription

This charge is billed to the end user who is the subscriber to the Telephone Exchange Service. In the event an end user is incorrectly presubscribed due to misassignment on the part of the Telephone Company, no charge shall apply. In the event an end user is incorrectly presubscribed due to misassignment on the part of the IXC, the Telephone Company will apply the charge to the IXC responsible. If the end user changes both interstate and intrastate presubscription at the same time, the intrastate presubscription charge will be ½ the rate listed above.

\*The switched access rate includes non-chargeable interface Group and Optional Features as set forth in 6.2(A)(1) and 6.2(A)(2).
