Enclosed with this electronic filing to psc@utah.gov is the proposed tariff sheet for Direct Communications – Cedar Valley (16-2419-T02) filed with the Division of Public Utilities as P.S.C. Utah No. 1.

This filing is made in accordance with R746-405. There is a Local Rate Ceiling of \$30 with respect to the CAF ICC and Access Recovery Charge (ARC) calculation. The ARC calculation is addressed in the Code of Federal Regulations 51.917 for revenue recovery for Rate-of-Return Carriers. The Local Rate Ceiling includes the residential rate, federal subscriber line charge of \$6.50, Extended Area Service of \$2.50 and an estimated 75 cents for state fees like USF and E911. If the residential rate is \$20.50 then the \$3 Residential Access Recovery Charge effective July 1, 2017 can be eliminated in the next CAF calculation. Direct Communications – Cedar Valley proposes to increase the residential rate from \$16.50 to \$20.50 and the Emergency Line from \$18 to \$20. This would bring the total residential Local Rate Ceiling to \$30 without the need to add the \$3 ARC in July 1, 2018.
