Dear Ms. Mercer,

The Public Service Commission of Utah ("PSC") reviewed the March 29, 2019 filing by TracFone Wireless. Inc. ("TracFone"), notifying the PSC of a change to its SafeLink Wireless Lifeline service offering in Utah. The filing was made pursuant to the PSC's September 18, 2018 Order Approving Stipulation and Settlement Agreement in this docket. According to TracFone, its Lifeline service complies with both 47 C.F.R. § 54.408(b)(2)-(3)) and Utah Admin. Code R746-8-403.

The PSC also reviewed the April 23, 2019 action request response filed by the Division of Public Utilities ("DPU"). The DPU concludes Tracfone's Lifeline plan satisfies Federal Communications Commission and PSC requirements. The DPU recommends the PSC acknowledge receipt of Tracfone's notification of changes to its Lifeline offerings.

Based on the PSC's review of the filing and the DPU's recommendations, the PSC acknowledges receipt of Tracfone's March 29, 2019 filing.
