**RECOMMENDATION (Acknowledgement):**

The Division of Public Utilities (“Division”) recommends that the Public Service Commission (“Commission”) acknowledge the requested name change from Cincinnati Bell Any Distance, Inc. to CBTS Technology Solutions, Inc.

**EXPLANATION:**
