Airus, Inc. (Airus) hereby submits an original and five copies of revisions to Utah Product Catalog No. 2. These tariff revisions are being filed in accordance with the Federal Communications Commission's ("FCC's") *Report and Order and Further Notice of Proposed Rulemaking* in Docket Nos. WC Docket No. 10-90, *et al.* (FCC 11-161, rel. 11/18/11) and related orders, and Sections 51.911 and 61.26 of the FCC's rules. This submission includes:

Airus hereby adds a cross-reference and URL hyperlink at page 102 to its interstate access tariff for all terminating per-minute-of use access rate elements. This filing is requested to become effective on July 31, 2017 (the same day Airus' interstate access tariff revisions are expected to go into effect).
