The Public Service Commission of Utah (“PSC”) reviewed the October 31, 2017 filing by Boomerang Wireless, LLC d/b/a. enTouch Wireless (“Boomerang”), of an update to its lifeline service offering. The PSC also reviewed the November 20, 2017 action request response filed by the Division of Public Utilities (“DPU”). The DPU states Boomerang’s filing fulfils the notification requirement for changes to Boomerang’s Lifeline service offering.¹ The DPU concludes there is no reason to deny the changes and recommends the PSC acknowledge the changes.

Based on the PSC’s review of the filing and the DPU’s response, the PSC acknowledges receiving the notice of changes to Boomerang’s Lifeline service offering as described in its October 31, 2017 filing.
