Dear Mr. Gipson,

The Public Service Commission of Utah (PSC) reviewed the June 21, 2023 filing by Boomerang Wireless, LLC d/b/a. enTouch Wireless ("Boomerang"), of an update to its lifeline services. Specifically, Boomerang has ceased using Verizon Wireless as one of its underlying carriers. The PSC also reviewed the June 28, 2023 comments filed by the Division of Public Utilities (DPU). DPU states Boomerang's filing fulfills the notification requirement for changes to Boomerang's Lifeline service offering.¹ The DPU concludes "there is no reason to deny the changes" and recommends the PSC acknowledge the changes.²
