1 PROCEEDINGS

2 OFFICER HAMMER: Good morning,
3 everyone. This is the time and place notified for
4 the hearing in the Matter of the Petition of Vaix,
5 Inc. dba Senawave Communications for Designation as
6 an Eligible Telecommunications Carrier for the
7 Purpose of Offering Lifeline Broadband Service in
8 the State of Utah. That's Commission Docket
9 No. 17-2598-01. My name is Michael Hammer, and I'm
10 the Commission's designated presiding officer.
11 Let's go ahead and take appearances, please.

12 MR. JETTER: Good morning. I'm
13 Justin Jetter with the Utah Attorney General's
14 Office, and I'm here today representing the Utah
15 Division of Public Utilities. With me at counsel
16 table is Casey Coleman with the Division. And just
17 as a preliminary note, after Mr. Bradshaw introduces
18 himself, if I could have just a moment to give a
19 little preliminary explanation of, I think, some
20 information that I think might help the hearing go
21 smoother.

22 OFFICER HAMMER: Absolutely.

23 MR. BRADSHAW: David Bradshaw from
24 Vaix on the conference call.

25 OFFICER HAMMER: Mr. Jetter.

1 MR. JETTER: So, we've had some
2 discussions regarding the SEC's, essentially, their
3 elimination of the type of ETC support and category
4 that was being sought in this application, and I
5 believe Mr. Bradshaw was intending to withdraw their
6 application this morning.

7 MR. BRADSHAW: That's correct.

8 MR. JETTER: I think we could just go
9 forward with that and we may not put a witness on.

10 OFFICER HAMMER: Mr. Bradshaw, do you
11 have anything else to say?

12 MR. BRADSHAW: We'd just like to
13 withdraw due to the Federal Government removing this
14 federal program.

15 OFFICER HAMMER: And, I'm sorry,
16 Mr. Bradshaw. What's your capacity at Vaix?

17 MR. BRADSHAW: I'm the chief
18 operating officer, the COO.

19 OFFICER HAMMER: Thank you very much.
20 Is there anything else?

21 MR. JETTER: Nothing from the
22 Division. Just, maybe being on the record, that we
23 support the withdrawal to the extent that we need to
24 and if the program were to come back, we'd be happy
25 to review it again.

1 OFFICER HAMMER: All right.

2 Mr. Bradshaw, anything else?

3 MR. BRADSHAW: No. Thank you very
4 much.

5 OFFICER HAMMER: Thank you, everyone.
6 We're adjourned.


