Re: In the Matter of Qwest Corporation d/b/a CenturyLink QC Additions to the Access Service Tariff per Docket No. 18-049-T02.

RECOMMENDATION: Approve Notification

The Division recommends that the Commission approve Qwest Corporation d/b/a CenturyLink QC ("CenturyLink") Additions to the Access Service Tariff.

BACKGROUND:

On May 11, 2018, CenturyLink filed the seventh step in implementing the Terminating Switched End Office Access Service reductions mandated in the Federal Communications Commission. The Tariff changes are required to transition to bill-and-keep as required by the 47 C.F.R §51.907(h).

The Division has reviewed the tariff and recommends the Commission approve the proposed tariff changes. CenturyLink has requested the filing be effective on July 3, 2018.
