Dear Ms. Zink,

On October 4, 2018, the Division of Public Utilities (“DPU”) filed a recommendation concerning whether adjustments to Navajo Communications Company, Inc.’s (“Navajo Communications”) Utah Universal Service Fund (“UUSF”) eligibility are necessary. The DPU correctly notes Navajo Communications is not presently receiving UUSF payments. The DPU recommends the Public Service Commission (“PSC”) take no action and represents that, based on its 2017 Annual Report, Navajo Communications does not qualify for UUSF payments in the 2019 calendar year.

On October 12, 2018, the PSC issued a Scheduling Order, allowing interested parties to file comments on the DPU’s recommendation. The PSC received no comments from Navajo Communications or any other party with respect to the DPU’s recommendation for Navajo Communications.

Having reviewed the DPU’s recommendation and there being no opposition, the PSC will take no further action in this docket.
