Dear Commissioners:


This letter notifies the Commission that the *Pro Forma* Consolidation of the Utah operations and assets of Crown Castle NG West LLC (“CCNG-West”) and NewPath Networks, LLC (“NewPath”) into Crown Castle Fiber LLC (“Crown Castle Fiber”) described in the above-referenced Joint Application was completed December 31, 2018. As a result, effective January 1, 2019, Crown Castle Fiber provides telecommunications services to CCNG-West and NewPath’s customers pursuant to Crown Castle Fiber’s Certificate 2608 issued on October 29, 2018 in Docket No. 18-2608-01.

Therefore, in accordance with the Joint Application and as reflected in the Commission’s Order approving the same, the Joint Applicants hereby request that Certificate No. 2445 held by

CCNG-West<sup>1</sup> and Certificate No. 2512 held by NewPath<sup>2</sup> be cancelled effective as of January 1, 2019.
