The Public Service Commission (PSC) reviewed the December 23, 2019 filing by i-wireless, LLC (“i-wireless”), regarding an update to its Lifeline service offering. i-wireless’s filing complies with requirements of the FCC and Utah Admin. Code R746-8-403(2)(a)(ii). Consistent with the FCC’s November 19, 2019 Order, i-wireless has increased its broadband Lifeline offering to include 3.0 GB of data per month. The PSC also reviewed the January 6, 2020 action request response filed by the Division of Public Utilities (DPU). The DPU recommends the PSC acknowledge i-wireless’s proposed changes to its Lifeline offering.

Based on the PSC’s review of the filing and the DPU’s response, the PSC acknowledges receiving the notice of changes to i-wireless’s Lifeline service offering as described in its December 23, 2019 filing.
