The Public Service Commission (PSC) reviewed the June 2, 2020 notice, filed by Sage Telecom Communications, LLC d/b/a TruConnect (“TruConnect”), of changes to its Lifeline service offering, effective December 1, 2019. TruConnect’s filing complies with requirements of the FCC and R746-8-403(2)(a)(ii). Consistent with the FCC’s November 19, 2019 Order, TruConnect has updated its Lifeline offering to include 1,000 voice minutes, unlimited text messages and 3 gigabytes of data at a net cost to Lifeline customers of \$0.00 (after application of Lifeline support). The PSC also reviewed the June 10, 2020 action request response filed by the Division of Public Utilities (DPU). The DPU recommends the PSC acknowledge receipt of TruConnect’s notification of proposed changes to its Lifeline offering and allow the effective date to be December 1, 2019.

Based on the PSC’s review of the filing and the DPU’s response, the PSC acknowledges receiving the notice of changes to TruConnect’s Lifeline service offering as described in its June 2, 2020 filing.
