SCHEDULING ORDER AND NOTICE OF STATUS AND SCHEDULING CONFERENCE

On June 28, 2019, the Public Service Commission (PSC) issued its Order and Action Request, directing the Division of Public Utilities (DPU) and the Office of Consumer Services (OCS) to file a proposed schedule for these dockets on or before July 8, 2019 and allowing Frontier Communications until July 15, 2019 to file comments on the proposal. On July 8, 2019, the DPU and the OCS jointly filed a Proposed Process, requesting the DPU's undocketed investigation be consolidated with Docket No. 19-041-04 and proposing the docket take place in two phases. The Proposed Process asks that in Phase I, the parties take initial discovery until September 16, 2019. After this period, the DPU and the OCS request the PSC hold a scheduling conference during which the DPU and the OCS intend to bring specific recommendations for the process of Phase II. The Proposed Process asks parties be allowed 10 days and use their best efforts to respond to informal discovery requests.

Frontier Communications filed no response to the Proposed Process.

Accordingly, good cause appearing, the PSC approves and adopts the Proposed Process.

DISCOVERY

Discovery turn-around times are ten days or best efforts through September 16, 2019.

Parties shall serve discovery requests and responses by electronic mail. In the event a document

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produced in response to a discovery request cannot reasonably be transmitted by electronic mail,

the party disclosing the document shall provide an electronic copy of the document on CD (or, if

an electronic copy is not available, a paper copy).
