ISSUE:

Frontier Communications of Utah submitted a filing dated April 18, 2019 to grandfather certain residential bundles in their Local Exchange Tariff (A-3).

RECOMMENDATION: Approve tariff filing.

The DPU has reviewed this filing and has no objection to Frontier Utah grandfathering certain residential bundles in their Local Exchange Tariff. There were no changes to existing rates and fees and no new language was added to the tariff. The only changes were to incorporate contact information and to the effective dates of the tariff.
