Dear Ms. Mersman,

The Public Service Commission (PSC) has reviewed Manti Telephone Company's ("Manti") proposed revisions to Sheet No. 109.6 of Manti's P.S.C. Utah No. 4 Tariff Section Concurrences Access Services, filed on September 24, 2019. Manti proposes to modify the Switched Access Service Local Switching-LTR-Intrastate Terminating Per Access Minute rate from \$0.00500 to \$0.00070 to be consistent with the requirements in FCC Rules. Manti requests an effective date of October 1, 2019. The PSC also reviewed the comments of the Division of Public Utilities (DPU) filed on September 27, 2019. The DPU states it has no objection to the proposed revision and recommends the PSC approve the revised tariff, effective October 1, 2019.

Based on Manti's filing and the DPU's comments and recommendation, the PSC approves Manti's revisions to Sheet No. 109.6 as filed.¹

¹ Going forward, Manti should (1) file tariff changes at least 30 days prior to the requested effective date as required by Utah Administrative Code (UAC) R746-405-1(C)(2); (2) file clean and redline versions of proposed tariff sheets as required by UAC R746-405-2(D)(6); and (3) provide a statement that the proposed tariff revisions do not constitute a violation of state law or PSC rule pursuant to UAC R746-405-2(D)(3)(g). We conclude, without prejudice to dissimilar conclusions in future filings, that in this instance these deficiencies are not material enough to be a basis to suspend or deny the tariff.
