The Public Service Commission (PSC) has reviewed Navajo Communications Company, Inc. d/b/a Frontier Navajo Communications Company's ("Navajo") proposed revisions to Sheet No. 4 of its Exchange Telephone Service, Section 4 ("Tariff"), transmitted on October 28, 2019. Navajo proposes revisions to incorporate the changes implemented by the 2016 FCC Lifeline Modernization Order. Navajo requests an effective date of December 1, 2019. The PSC also reviewed the comments of the Division of Public Utilities (DPU) filed on November 5, 2019. The DPU has no objections with the proposed revisions and recommends the PSC approve Navajo's proposed revisions to the Tariff.

Based on its review of Navajo's filing and the DPU's comments and recommendation, the PSC approves Navajo's proposed revisions to its Tariff as filed, with an effective date of December 1, 2019.
