Dear Ms. Zink,

The Public Service Commission (PSC) has reviewed Navajo Communications Company, Inc. dba Frontier Navajo Communications Company's ("Navajo") proposed revisions to Sheet No. 3 of its General Exchange Tariff – Utah, Section 16 ("Tariff"), transmitted on October 28, 2019. Navajo proposes to include less restrictive language regarding its Vacation Get Away Service available to customers. Navajo requests an effective date of December 1, 2019 for these changes. The PSC also reviewed the comments of the Division of Public Utilities (DPU) filed on November 12, 2019. The DPU states it has no objection to Navajo's proposed Tariff changes and recommends the PSC approve them as filed.

Based on the PSC's review of Navajo's filing and the DPU's comments and recommendation, the PSC approves Navajo's proposed revisions to its Tariff as filed, with an effective date of December 1, 2019.
