NOTICE REGARDING DPU'S REQUEST  
FOR EXTENSION OF TIME AND ORDER  
SUSPENDING TARIFF

---

ISSUED: May 13, 2019

On April 15, 2019, South Central Utah Telephone Association, Inc. ("SCUTA"), filed with the Public Service Commission of Utah ("PSC") Advice Letter No. T-19-052-T01, proposing revisions to its local tariff ("Tariff"). SCUTA requests an effective date of May 14, 2019 for these Tariff modifications. SCUTA's filing proposes to: 1) clean up outdated tariff sheets; 2) add new service offerings; and 3) delete services where there are no customers.

On April 15 and May 6, 2019, the PSC issued action requests to the Division of Public Utilities ("DPU"). On May 8, 2019, the DPU filed a request for an extension of time until June 30, 2019 to respond to the action requests. The DPU states it is awaiting SCUTA's response to the DPU's data request before it can fully review the Tariff and respond to the action requests. As a result of SCUTA's communications with the DPU, on May 8, 2019, SCUTA filed corrected Tariff Sheet Nos. 22 and 23.

For good cause appearing, the PSC grants the DPU's request for extension of time until July 1, 2019.<sup>1</sup> SCUTA may immediately file a request for the PSC to conduct a scheduling conference if it desires a quicker resolution to this docket.

Because the DPU's action request response deadline is after the proposed Tariff effective date of May 14, 2019, the Tariff changes SCUTA proposes in this docket are suspended and

shall not become effective by operation of statute, pending further order from the PSC. *See* Utah Code Ann. § 54-7-12(5)(a).
