The Public Service Commission (PSC) has reviewed UBTA-UBET Communications, Inc.'s ("UBTA-UBET") proposed revisions to Sheet Nos. 3.3 and 234.1 of its P.S.C.U. No. 1 Access Service Tariff ("Tariff"), transmitted on June 18, 2019. UBTA-UBET proposes to modify End of Office terminating rates to be consistent with the requirements in FCC Rules. UBTA-UBET requests an effective date of July 1, 2019. The PSC also reviewed the comments of the Division of Public Utilities (DPU) filed on June 24, 2019. The DPU supports UBTA-UBET's proposed modification and recommends the PSC approve the revised tariff.

Based on its review of UBTA-UBET's filing and the DPU's comments and recommendation, the PSC approves UBTA-UBET's proposed revision to its Tariff as filed, with an effective date of July 1, 2019.<sup>1</sup>
