Dear Mr. Asay,

The Public Service Commission (PSC) has reviewed Union Telephone Company's, ("Union") proposed revisions to Page No. 62 of its P.S.C.U. No. 3 Access Service Tariff ("Tariff"), transmitted on June 17, 2019. Union proposes to modify End of Office terminating rates to be consistent with the requirements in FCC Rules. Union requests an effective date of July 1, 2019. The PSC also reviewed the comments of the Division of Public Utilities (DPU) filed on June 25, 2019. The DPU supports Union's proposed modification and recommends the PSC approve the revised tariff.

Based on its review of Union's filing and the DPU's comments and recommendation, the PSC approves Union's proposed revision to its Tariff as filed, with an effective date of July 1, 2019.¹

¹ Going forward, the PSC reminds Union of the requirements to (1) file tariff changes at least 30 days prior to the requested effective date as specified in Utah Administrative Code (UAC) R746-405-1(C)(2); and (2) provide a statement that the proposed tariff sheet does not constitute a violation of state law or PSC rule per Utah Admin. Code R746-405-2(D)(3)(g).
