The Public Service Commission (PSC) has reviewed All West Communications, Inc.'s ("All West") proposed revisions to Sheet No. 61 of its PUC No. 2, Local Acess Service Tariff ("Tariff"), transmitted on October 31, 2019. All West proposes revisions to incorporate the changes implemented by the 2016 FCC Lifeline Modernization Order. All West requests an effective date of December 1, 2019. The PSC also reviewed the comments of the Division of Public Utilities (DPU) filed on November 13, 2019. The DPU finds no issue with the proposed revisions and recommends the PSC approve All West's proposed revisions to the Tariff.

Based on its review of All West's filing and the DPU's comments and recommendation, the PSC approves All West's proposed revisions to its Tariff as filed, with an effective date of December 1, 2019.¹
