Dear Ms. Kirby,

The Public Service Commission (PSC) reviewed the December 8, 2020 filing by Stand Up Wireless (“Stand Up”) of an update to its Lifeline service offering. Stand Up has increased its broadband Lifeline offering to include 1,000 voice minutes, along with 4.5 GB of data per month, and unlimited text messages. The PSC also reviewed the December 15, 2020 action request response filed by the Division of Public Utilities (DPU). DPU confirms Stand Up’s offering complies with the Federal Communications Commission’s minimum service standards, and recommends the PSC acknowledge Stand Up’s proposed changes to its Lifeline offering and allow the effective date to be December 1, 2020.

Based on the PSC’s review of the filing and DPU’s response, the PSC acknowledges receiving Stand Up’s notice of changes to its Lifeline service offering as described in its December 8, 2020 filing.
