The Public Service Commission (PSC) reviewed the letter filed April 15, 2022 (“Filing”) by Global Connection Inc. of America d/b/a STAND UP WIRELESS (“Stand Up”). The Filing gives notice of an update to Stand Up’s Lifeline service offering to include unlimited voice minutes, unlimited text messages, and 4.5 gigabytes of data at no net cost to the Lifeline customer after application of Lifeline and Utah USF support.

The PSC also reviewed the May 3, 2022 comments filed by the Division of Public Utilities (DPU). DPU recommends the PSC acknowledge the Filing. DPU states that Stand Up is required to notify the PSC of any changes to its service offerings by the order granting it ETC status in Utah, and the changes appear to meet the Federal Communications Commission’s minimum service standards. DPU states it sees no reason to deny Stand Up’s proposed changes.

Based on the PSC’s review of the Filing and on DPU’s comments and recommendation, the PSC acknowledges receiving Stand Up’s Filing.
