ORDER ACKNOWLEDGING NEW NAME AND AMENDING CERTIFICATE OF PUBLIC CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY

BACKGROUND

On January 23, 2018, in Docket No. 17-2600-01, the Public Service Commission of Utah (PSC) granted Birch Communications, Inc. ("Birch Inc.") a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity, authorizing the company to provide competitive local exchange services within the State of Utah.

On March 12, 2018, in Docket No. 18-2600-T01, ¹ Birch Inc. filed a letter notifying the PSC that it had changed its name to Birch Communications, LLC ("Birch LLC"). On June 24, 2019, Birch LLC filed a letter in this docket requesting approval from the PSC to change its name to Fusion Cloud Services, LLC, effective June 30, 2019. ² Birch LLC states a notice of the name change is being provided to Utah customers via bill message and that the name change will not affect terms and conditions of service being offered to Utah customers.

On June 25, 2019, the Division of Public Utilities (DPU) filed a memorandum recommending that the PSC acknowledge the name change.

Therefore the PSC acknowledges and approves the name change to Fusion Cloud Services, LLC and amends the affected Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to reflect the new business name. Responses to a request for agency review or rehearing must be filed within 15 days of the filing of the request for review or rehearing. If the Commission fails to grant a request for review or rehearing within 20 days after the filing of a request for review or rehearing, it is deemed denied. Judicial review of the Commission's final agency action may be obtained by filing a Petition for Review with the Utah Supreme Court within 30 days after final agency action. Any Petition for Review must comply with the requirements of Utah Code Ann. §§ 63G-4-401, 63G-4-403, and the Utah Rules of Appellate Procedure.
