Dear Ms. Wimer,

The Public Service Commission (PSC) has reviewed Skyline Telecom's ("Skyline") proposed revisions to Page Nos. 48 and 50 of its Access Service, Skyline Telecom, P.S.C. Utah No. 2 Tariff ("Tariff"), transmitted on May 31, 2019. Skyline proposes to modify End of Office terminating rates to be consistent with the requirements in FCC Rules. Skyline requests an effective date of July 2, 2019. The PSC also reviewed the comments of the Division of Public Utilities (DPU) filed on June 13, 2019. The DPU supports Skyline's proposed modification and recommends the PSC approve the revised tariff.

Based on its review of Skyline's filing and the DPU's comments and recommendation, the PSC approves Skyline's proposed revision to its Tariff as filed, with an effective date of July 2, 2019.<sup>1</sup>
