Dear Mr. Rutkowski,

The Public Service Commission (PSC) has reviewed All West Communications, Inc.'s ("All West") Advice Letter No. UT-20-01 regarding proposed revisions to its P.S.C.U. Tariff No. 1, Sheet No. 208 ("Tariff"), filed May 18, 2020. All West states the filing is made in compliance with the Federal Communication Commission's ("FCC") Title 47: Telecommunication; Part 51-Interconnection; Subpart J-Transitional Access Service Pricing; § 51.909 Transition of rate-of-return carrier access charges; Step 9. All West explains that, effective July 1, 2020, it will be exiting the National Exchange Carriers Association F.C.C Tariff No. 5 for its interstate switched access and special access rates. Instead, it will file specific rates developed in accordance with FCC rules, and will list its interstate switched and special rates in the Moss Adams F.C.C. Tariff No. 1. The proposed changes update the interstate tariff. All West requests an effective date of July 1, 2020. The PSC also reviewed the comments of the Division of Public Utilities (DPU) filed on May 27, 2020. DPU recommends the PSC approve the requested tariff revisions.

Based on its review of All West's filing and DPU's comments and recommendation, the PSC approves All West's proposed revisions to its Tariff as filed, effective July 1, 2020.<sup>1</sup>
