ORDER ACKNOWLEDGING NAME
CHANGE AND AMENDING CERTIFICATE
OF PUBLIC CONVENIENCE AND
NECESSITY

BACKGROUND

On December 22, 1999, in Docket No. 99-2287-01, the Public Service Commission (PSC) granted New Edge Networks, Inc. a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity (“CPCN”), authorizing the company to provide public telecommunications services within the State of Utah. Subsequently, through various proceedings, New Edge Networks, Inc. ultimately changed its name to EarthLink Business, LLC (“Earthlink”). On November 23, 2020, Earthlink filed a letter with the PSC indicating it had changed its name to Windstream New Edge, LLC.

On November 24, 2020, the Division of Public Utilities filed a memorandum recommending the PSC acknowledge the name, make necessary changes to all relevant documents, and adjudicate the docket informally in accordance with Utah Admin. Code R746-110-1.

ORDER

Having reviewed the records, the PSC acknowledges the name “Windstream New Edge, LLC” and amends the affected CPCN to reflect the name change. The amended CPCN is attached as Exhibit A.

Notice of Opportunity for Agency Review or Rehearing

Pursuant to Utah Code Ann. §§ 63G-4-301 and 54-7-15, a party may seek agency review or rehearing of this order by filing a request for review or rehearing with the PSC within 30 days after the issuance of the order. Responses to a request for agency review or rehearing must be filed within 15 days of the filing of the request for review or rehearing. If the PSC fails to grant a request for review or rehearing within 30 days after the filing of a request for review or rehearing, it is deemed denied. Judicial review of the PSC's final agency action may be obtained by filing a Petition for Review with the Utah Supreme Court within 30 days after final agency action. Any Petition for Review must comply with the requirements of Utah Code Ann. §§ 63G-4-401, 63G-4-403, and the Utah Rules of Appellate Procedure.
