BACKGROUND

On June 18, 2002, in Docket No. 01-2366-01, the Public Service Commission of Utah (PSC) granted Intrado Communications, Inc. ("Intrado Inc.") a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity (CPCN), authorizing the company to provide public telecommunications services within the State of Utah. On March 16, 2016, in Docket No. 16-2366-01, the PSC acknowledged Intrado Inc.'s name change to West Safety Communications Inc. ("West Safety") and amended its CPCN to reflect said name change.

On March 13, 2020, West Safety filed a letter with the PSC indicating the company will be changing its name to Intrado Safety Communications, Inc. ("Intrado") effective immediately. Intrado also filed a price list to reflect the name change.

On March 20, 2020, the Division of Public Utilities (DPU) filed a memorandum recommending the PSC acknowledge the name change and make the necessary changes and amendments to all required documents.

ORDER

Having reviewed the records, the PSC acknowledges the name Intrado Safety Communications, Inc. and amends the affected Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity

to reflect the new business name. The amended Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity is attached as Exhibit A.

Notice of Opportunity for Agency Review or Rehearing

Pursuant to Utah Code Ann. §§ 63G-4-301 and 54-7-15, a party may seek agency review or rehearing of this order by filing a request for review or rehearing with the PSC within 30 days after the issuance of the order. Responses to a request for agency review or rehearing must be filed within 15 days of the filing of the request for review or rehearing. If the PSC fails to grant a request for review or rehearing within 20 days after the filing of a request for review or rehearing, it is deemed denied. Judicial review of the PSC's final agency action may be obtained by filing a Petition for Review with the Utah Supreme Court within 30 days after final agency action. Any Petition for Review must comply with the requirements of Utah Code Ann. §§ 63G-4-401, 63G-4-403, and the Utah Rules of Appellate Procedure.
