1 P R O C E E D I N G S

2 -o0o-

3 HEARING OFFICER HOGLE: Thank you, everybody.
4 Good afternoon. It is approximately 1:33 in the
5 afternoon on May 19th, 2021. My name is Yvonne Hogle,
6 and I am the Public Service Commission's designated
7 presiding officer for this docket.

8 This is the date and time for the Commission to
9 consider the settlement stipulation that was entered into
10 between the Utah Division of Public Utilities and Direct
11 Communications Cedar Valley, LLC, related to the 2019
12 annual report of Direct Communications Cedar Valley, LLC,
13 Docket No. 20-2419-01.

14 Let's take appearances for the record, please,
15 starting with the applicant.

16 MR. IRVINE: David Irvine for Direct
17 Communications.

18 HEARING OFFICER HOGLE: Mr. Irvine, do you have
19 a witness that will be presenting the settlement
20 stipulation on behalf of Direct Communications?

21 MR. IRVINE: Yes. That will be Mr. Chad Duval
22 from Moss Adams.

23 HEARING OFFICER HOGLE: Okay. Thank you.

24 For the Division, please.

25 MR. JETTER: Good morning, I'm -- or good

1 afternoon, excuse me. I'm Justin Jetter with the Utah
2 Attorney General's office, and today I'm here
3 representing the Utah Division of Public Utilities.

4 The Division will -- intends today to call one
5 witness, Gary Smith. He is on the conference with us.
6 And a second analyst from the Division, Shauna
7 Benvegna-Springer, is with us today, but I don't intend
8 to call her as a witness unless we have some questions
9 that only she might be able to answer.

10 HEARING OFFICER HOGLE: Okay. Thank you.

11 Do we have anybody else on the line from any
12 other party? I didn't expect there to be, so okay, there
13 isn't anyone on the line.

14 So, I'm aware that there is some confidential
15 material in the settlement stipulation, and my hope is
16 that we won't have to reference it during the hearing.
17 However, if either party finds it necessary to reference
18 that material, please let us know right away so that we
19 can stop the streaming. We're currently streaming, and
20 this is available to the public.

21 And with that, Mr. Irvine, are you ready to call
22 your first witness?

23 MR. IRVINE: Judge, I was under the impression
24 that the Division would be presenting the stipulation.
25 If I'm in error, I apologize. I'm prepared to respond.

1 HEARING OFFICER HOGLE: That is fine. We can
2 have the Division go first.

3 Mr. Jetter, are you prepared to call your first
4 witness -- or your witness?

5 MR. JETTER: Yes, that would be great. We can
6 get started. The Division would like to call and have
7 sworn in Gary Smith.

8 HEARING OFFICER HOGLE: Mr. Smith, do you swear
9 to tell the truth?

10 THE WITNESS: Yes.

11 HEARING OFFICER HOGLE: Okay. Thank you.

12

13 GARY SMITH,

14 was called as a witness, and having been first duly
15 sworn to tell the truth, the whole truth, and nothing
16 but the truth, testified as follows:

17

18 DIRECT EXAMINATION

19 BY MR. JETTER:

20 Q. Good morning, Mr. Smith. Would you please state
21 your name and occupation for the record of this hearing.

22 A. Gary Smith, a utility technical consultant for
23 the Division of Public Utilities, State of Utah.

24 Q. Thank you. And in the course of your employment
25 with the Division of Public Utilities, have you had the

1 opportunity to review the filing of the annual report in
2 this docket? I believe that was filed in, let's see,
3 April 16th of 2020, and then a number of filings that
4 were made since then.

5 A. Yes, I have.

6 Q. And did you participate in the negotiation of
7 the settlement presented by the Division and the
8 applicants in this docket?

9 A. Yes.

10 Q. Do you have a brief summary of the Division's
11 position and your analysis that you'd like to enter into
12 the record?

13 A. I do.

14 Q. Please go ahead.

15 A. On April 16th, 2020, Direct Communications Cedar
16 Valley, Limited Liability Corporation, or DCCV, filed its
17 annual report for the calendar year 2019 with the
18 Commission. The Division of Public Utilities, or
19 Division, after review and discussion with DCCV filed
20 comments with the Commission on September 30th, 2020,
21 recommending the suspension of Utah Universal
22 Telecommunications Service Support Funding.

23 After additional discovery and discussions with
24 DCCV, the Division filed comments on November 16th, 2020,
25 recommending the Commission adjust the UUSF support for

1 DCCV to 2,465,886 annually, effective June 1st, 2021.

2 On November 18th of 2020, the Division filed
3 amended comments to include an adjustment for excess
4 deferred income taxes, or EDIT, reducing the 2021 UUSF
5 support recommendation by 83,314 annually.

6 On January 4th of 2021, the Commission issued
7 its order setting the 2021 UUSF distribution to DCCV by
8 adopting the Division's recommendation of 2,382,572
9 annually and provided notice that it intended to hold an
10 evidentiary hearing to determine DCCV's eligibility for
11 certain expenses disputed between the parties.

12 The Division and DCCV engaged in significant
13 additional review of DCCV's expenses and lengthy
14 good-faith negotiations regarding expenses in dispute.

15 Based on the review and evaluation of the
16 information provided through informal discovery filings
17 and settlement discussions, the Division and DCCV,
18 pursuant to Utah Code 54-7-1, have entered a stipulation
19 regarding DCCV's Utah Universal Telecommunication Service
20 Support Funding to be received in 2021.

21 The parties have reached an agreement as set
22 forth in the filed stipulation that DCCV is eligible for
23 a total of 2 million 983 --

24 HEARING OFFICER HOGLE: Mr. Smith --

25 THE WITNESS: -- thousand, nine hundred and

1 eighty -- I'm sorry?

2 HEARING OFFICER HOGLE: Mr. Smith, I apologize.
3 I just wanted to make sure that you were not going to be
4 testifying regarding the confidential numbers. I thought
5 you were going to go there. So I apologize for
6 interrupting, but I see that you did not disclose that
7 confidential number. So please proceed. My apologies
8 again. Go ahead.

9 THE WITNESS: Okay.

10 -- and UUSF support during the 2021 calendar
11 year, retroactively beginning January 1st, 2021, in the
12 amount of 248,665.50 per month.

13 The Division recommends that the Commission
14 approve the stipulation. As a whole, it is just and
15 reasonable in result and in the public interest.

16 MR. JETTER: Thank you, Mr. Smith.

17 I have no further questions for Mr. Smith. He's
18 available for cross-examination or questions from the
19 Hearing Officer.

20 HEARING OFFICER HOGLE: Thank you, Mr. Smith.

21 Mr. Irvine, do you have any questions for
22 Mr. Smith?

23 MR. IRVINE: I do not.

24 HEARING OFFICER HOGLE: Okay. I do not, either.
25 Thank you, Mr. Smith, for taking the time to

1 testify in this hearing. Thank you.

2 THE WITNESS: Thank you.

3 HEARING OFFICER HOGLE: Okay, Mr. Irvine.

4 MR. IRVINE: I'd like to call Mr. Chad Duval as
5 DCCV's expert witness in this matter.

6 HEARING OFFICER HOGLE: Mr. Duval, do you swear
7 to tell the truth? You're muted, so if you can unmute.

8 THE WITNESS: Yes. Still yes.

9 HEARING OFFICER HOGLE: Thank you. Thank you.

10 MR. IRVINE: That was a nice attempt to avoid
11 being sworn in. Congratulations.

12 THE WITNESS: Unfortunately, you can't do that
13 on the witness stand in the room.

14 HEARING OFFICER HOGLE: Okay. Please proceed,
15 Mr. Irvine.

16

17 CHAD DUVAL,

18 was called as a witness, and having been first duly
19 sworn to tell the truth, the whole truth, and nothing
20 but the truth, testified as follows:

21

22 DIRECT EXAMINATION

23 MR. IRVINE: Judge, Mr. Duval has previously
24 testified before the Utah Public Service Commission. He
25 has been an expert witness in previous dockets. I

1 believe the last time he appeared in a witness capacity
2 was 2003.

3 Is that correct, Mr. Duval?

4 THE WITNESS: 2003 and 2004, yes.

5 MR. IRVINE: Okay. Just briefly for your
6 benefit, I'd like to ask Mr. Duval a couple of background
7 questions to establish his credentials as an expert, if
8 you would like me to.

9 HEARING OFFICER HOGLE: Go ahead, Mr. Irvine.

10 **Q. (BY MR. IRVINE:) Mr. Duval, could you briefly**
11 **go through your educational and professional**
12 **qualifications?**

13 A. Sure. I am currently a partner with Moss Adams,
14 which is the 12th largest accounting consulting firm in
15 the nation. I'm a partner in our communications and
16 media practice with offices, personally, in both
17 Stockton, California, as well as Dallas, Texas. I am the
18 leader of our communications and media, our
19 telecommunications consulting practice.

20 Been with Moss Adams for over 16 years now.
21 I've been in the telecommunications industry in a
22 consulting capacity throughout my entire career of over
23 25 years.

24 I have a bachelor's degree -- a bachelor of
25 science degree in business administration with an

1 emphasis in statistics from the University of Denver.

2 I've previously, besides testifying before the
3 Utah Public Service Commission, I've testified before 11
4 additional state public utilities commissions across the
5 country. I've performed training for both the FCC as
6 well as the Universal Service Administrative Company on
7 federal regulatory policy and federal regulatory rules.

8 And so I guess I will leave it at that unless
9 there are other questions related to my background and
10 experience as an expert witness.

11 **Q. Mr. Duval, how many other public service**
12 **commissions have you testified before in your duties with**
13 **Moss Adams?**

14 A. Sure. In my duties with Moss Adams as well
15 as --

16 **Q. -- other states?**

17 A. -- as the other firm that I worked for prior to
18 Moss Adams, I have provided expert witness testimony
19 before 11 public service commissions in addition to the
20 Utah Public Service Commission.

21 **Q. Thank you.**

22 MR. IRVINE: If there are no questions with
23 respect to Mr. Duval's qualifications, your Honor, I
24 would ask that he be accepted as an expert witness in
25 this matter.

1 HEARING OFFICER HOGLE: Okay.

2 Q. (BY MR. IRVINE:) Mr. Duval, you heard the
3 witness related to the events that followed the creation
4 of this docket and the appeal of a recommendation from
5 the Division of Public Utilities at the end of calendar
6 year 2020.

7 Did you represent Direct Communications in the
8 negotiations with the Division with respect to the
9 stipulation before the Commission today?

10 A. Yes, I did with the assistance of a couple of
11 colleagues of mine. But I was the lead participant on
12 behalf of the Company.

13 Q. Was there anything in the testimony of
14 Mr. Smith, as you understood it, that you believe needs
15 to be further clarified or explained from your
16 perspective?

17 A. No. I believe that Mr. Smith gave a
18 representative and well-explained discussion of the
19 stipulation and the process.

20 Q. In your opinion -- or let me just restate that.
21 Do you have an opinion that the stipulation as
22 proposed to the Commission is just and reasonable?

23 A. Yes, I do believe it is just and reasonable.

24 MR. IRVINE: Judge, unless there are other
25 questions of Mr. Duval, that's a summary of the Company's

1 position. We support the stipulation. We encourage the
2 Commission to accept it, adopt it as it has been filed.

3 HEARING OFFICER HOGLE: Thank you.

4 Mr. Irvine, I did hear you use or describe in
5 your words the settlement stipulation as being just and
6 reasonable.

7 Do you think it's in the public interest as
8 well?

9 MR. IRVINE: Yes, I do.

10 HEARING OFFICER HOGLE: Okay.

11 MR. IRVINE: This has been a long negotiation
12 process, and both sides have worked in good faith to
13 achieve it. Hopefully, we have resolved some issues that
14 needed to be resolved, and we're satisfied with it.

15 HEARING OFFICER HOGLE: Okay. Thank you,
16 Mr. Irvine.

17 I neglected to ask Mr. Jetter if he had any
18 questions for Mr. Duval. So, Mr. Jetter?

19 MR. JETTER: I do not have any questions. Thank
20 you.

21 HEARING OFFICER HOGLE: Okay. Other than the
22 one question that I had, I don't have a question for
23 Mr. Duval.

24 So, thank you, Mr. Duval, for your time today
25 and for testifying on behalf of DCCV and in support of a

1 settlement stipulation.

2 Does anybody else have any anything that they
3 would like to add or anything that I may have missed?
4 Please let me know at this moment.

5 Okay. Again, thank you both parties for your
6 time today. And we will be issuing an order shortly soon
7 in this case. So, we are adjourned. Thank you.

8 (The matter concluded at 1:49 p.m.)
