Re: *Petition of Q Link Wireless LLC to Expand its Eligible Telecommunications Carrier Service Area in Utah; Docket No. 20-2549-01*

Dear Ms. Kirby,

The Public Service Commission (PSC) reviewed the December 10, 2020 filing by Q Link Wireless LLC (“Q Link”) of an update to its Lifeline service offering. Q Link has increased its broadband Lifeline offering to include 1,000 voice minutes, along with 4.5 GB of data per month, and unlimited text messages. The PSC also reviewed the January 5, 2021 action request response filed by the Division of Public Utilities (DPU). DPU confirms Q Link’s offering complies with the Federal Communications Commission’s minimum service standards, and recommends the PSC acknowledge Q Link’s proposed changes to its Lifeline offering and allow the effective date to be December 1, 2020.

Based on the PSC’s review of the filing and DPU’s response, the PSC acknowledges receiving Q Link’s notice of changes to its Lifeline service offering as described in its December 10, 2020 filing.
