**APPLICANTS' RESPONSE TO  
FRONTIER'S MOTION TO VACATE SCHEDULING ORDER**

On July 28, 2020, Citizens Telecommunications Company of Utah d/b/a Frontier Communications (“Frontier”) filed a Motion to Vacate the Scheduling Order in this docket pending the Utah Public Service Commission’s (“Commission”) determination of Frontier’s Motion for Summary Judgment. E Fiber Moab, LLC (“E Fiber Moab”) and E Fiber San Juan, LLC (“E Fiber San Juan”) (E Fiber Moab and E Fiber San Juan collectively the “Applicants”) are not opposed to suspending the Scheduling Order pending Commission determination of the Motion for Summary Judgment **provided that the due date for non-applicant testimony be rescheduled for one week after the Commission’s Order on the Motion for Summary Judgment is issued.**

As the Commission is aware, Applicants filed their direct testimony on June 24, 2020. Under the current Scheduling Order Non-applicant Direct Testimony is due August 5, 2020, which is one week from today. If the Commission is inclined to grant the Motion to Vacate the Scheduling Order, the Applicants would request that the deadline for non-applicant testimony be

set for one week after the Commission's Order on the Motion for Summary Judgment is issued, and all other dates should follow in reasonable order from that date on the same or similar intervals as contained in the current scheduling order.
