The Public Service Commission (PSC) has reviewed Citizens Telecommunications Company of Utah d/b/a Frontier Communications of Utah's ("Frontier") proposed revisions to Sheet No. 1 of its Network Access Line Service tariff ("Tariff"), transmitted on October 29, 2021. The purpose of this filing is to change the Federal Lifeline Support Credit – Voice discount from \$5.25 to \$6.50 as a result of the FCC's Lifeline Modernization, WC Docket No. 11-42, Order No: FCC 16-38, issued April 27, 2016. Frontier requests an effective date of December 1, 2021 for these changes.

The PSC also reviewed the comments of the Division of Public Utilities (DPU) filed on November 4, 2021. The DPU states it has no objections to the proposed changes and recommends the PSC approve Frontier's proposed revisions to the Tariff.

Based on its review of Frontier's filing and DPU's comments and recommendation, the PSC approves Frontier's proposed revisions to its Tariff, as filed, effective December 1, 2021.
