Dear Ms. Matushek,

On April 13, 2021, Navajo filed its Annual Report for Calendar Year 2020 (“Report”) with the Public Service Commission (PSC). On October 4, 2021, the Division of Public Utilities (DPU) filed its recommendation with the PSC stating that, based on its review of the Report, Navajo does not qualify for Utah Universal Public Telecommunications Support Fund (“UUSF”) payments in calendar year 2022. The DPU noted that Navajo is not currently receiving distributions from the UUSF and that no adjustments to the UUSF eligibility for Navajo are necessary. On October 7, 2021, the PSC issued a Notice of Filing and Comment Period, seeking comments on DPU’s recommendation on or before November 1, 2021. The PSC received no comments.

Based on the PSC’s review of the Report, and on DPU’s uncontested recommendation, and there being no comments or reply comments filed during the comment period, the PSC finds and concludes that Navajo does not qualify for a disbursement from the UUSF in 2022 under Utah Code Ann. § 54-8b-15. The PSC will take no further action in this docket.
