Dear Ms. Zink,

On October 20, 2021, Navajo Communications Company, Inc. d/b/a Frontier Navajo Communications Company (“Navajo”), Emery Telecommunications & Video, Inc., E Fiber San Juan, LLC, and E Fiber Moab, LLC (“E Fiber”) filed with the Public Service Commission (PSC) an agreement for local interconnection (“Agreement”). The proposed Agreement defines the general terms and conditions by which Navajo and E Fiber will interconnect their telecommunications networks, operate, route calls, settle accounts, and undertake other required interactions.

On October 26, 2021, the Division of Public Utilities (DPU) filed comments recommending the PSC acknowledge receipt of the Agreement.

There being no recommendation opposing the Agreement, the PSC acknowledges that consistent with 47 U.S.C. § 252(e), the Agreement is deemed approved, effective January 18, 2022.
