Dear Ms. Zink,

The Public Service Commission (PSC) has reviewed Navajo Communications Company, Inc. dba Frontier Navajo Communications Company's ("Navajo") proposed revisions to its General Exchange Tariff – Utah, Section 8, Sheet Nos. 45 and 46 ("Tariff"), transmitted on April 20, 2021. The purpose of this filing is to introduce Navajo Unlimited Voice and Feature Bundle, and make it available to residential customers where it is technically feasible. Navajo requests an effective date of May 23, 2021 for these changes.

The PSC also reviewed the comments of the Division of Public Utilities (DPU) filed on May 3, 2021. The DPU states it has no objections to the proposed changes and recommends the PSC approve Navajo's proposed revisions to the Tariff with the requested effective date. According to DPU, the proposed Tariff revisions will not affect Navajo's overall revenue picture and no other rates are affected.

Based on its review of Navajo's filing and DPU's comments and recommendation, the PSC approves Navajo's proposed revisions to its Tariff, as filed, effective May 23, 2021.
