Dear Ms. Zink,

The Public Service Commission (PSC) has reviewed Navajo Communications Company, Inc. dba Frontier Navajo Communications Company's ("Navajo") proposed revisions to its General Exchange Tariff – Utah, Section 0, Sheet No. 1 and Section 10, Sheet No. 10 ("Tariff"), filed July 19, 2021 (the "Filing"). The intent of proposed changes to the Tariff is to introduce a Duplicate Bill Charge of \$5.00 to provide a printed copy of current and/or previous months' billing. Navajo requests an effective date of August 19, 2021.

The PSC also reviewed the comments of the Division of Public Utilities (DPU) filed on July 26, 2021 ("Recommendation"). DPU has no objections to the proposed changes, and recommends approval of the Tariff's proposed changes, effective August 19, 2021. According to DPU, the proposed Tariff changes will neither affect Navajo's overall revenue picture, nor any other rates. DPU adds that the proposed \$5.00 charge does not seem unreasonable.

Based on its review of the Filing and DPU's Recommendation, the PSC approves the proposed changes to the Tariff as filed, effective August 19, 2021.
